To learn about local wisdom, the children of Sotpattana School for the Deaf and pre-school kids from the Pattaya Orphanage visited a pineapple plantation located in Nong Prue sub-district, Banglamung district, owned by parents of a former deaf student. Our kids were happy to learn a lot more about pineapples, how to grow, maintain, and harvest them. They have learned not only from seeing the plants but also from touching them and hearing about their usefulness as food and economic produce. Episode 9: The Feel of Givers

The devastating flooding situation in Thailand this year is one of the worst disasters in decades. When the 10 kids had a chance to tell the group at home of their experiences, certain expressions they had in common were that the flood victims had a real difficult life; there was a joy in their hearts to be able to help people in need; and there was a real value in giving.

We do hope that the care and concern from orphaned kids and all of us would empower the affected people in their struggles until the situation is back to normal and smiles are seen on their faces once again.
